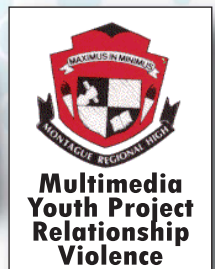
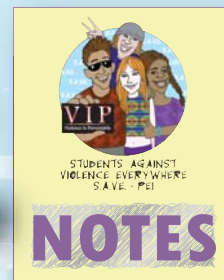
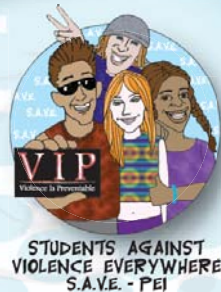
# DO YOU: ARE YOU: HELP:
